WHAT IS THE CHURCH?

THE WORD 'CHURCH' MEANS A 'called out' ASSEMBLY.

Those who believed and were baptised were added to the Church (called out assembly) at Jerusalem Acts 2 v 41, 47.

In a similar way local Churches were planted at Antioch, Corinth, and in many other places. Acts 13 v 1. 1 Corinthians 1 v 1-3
